STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing on Watchic Pond, in the Town of Standish, in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. For a period of two years from the time this

- 2 act takes effect it shall be unlawful for any person to fish
- 3 for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time on or
- 4 through the ice in Watchic pond, so-called, in the town of
- 5 Standish, in the county of Cumberland.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-

- 2 sion at any time any kind of fish taken on or through the
- 3 ice in said pond.

- Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 pay a fine of not less than ten nor more than thirty dollars 3 and costs for each offense, and one dollar additional for 4 each fish taken, caught or killed or had in possession in vio-5 lation of this act.
- Sect. 3. Trial justices, police and municipal courts, within 2 their respective counties shall have, upon complaint, orig-3 inal and concurrent jurisdiction with the supreme judicial 4 court and superior courts in all prosecutions arising under 5 this act.
