### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Prohibiting the Catching of Smelts in the Cathance River except by Hook and Line.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. No smelts shall be caught, taken or fished for
2 in any way other than by hook and line, except in nets of
3 two inch mesh or more, in the waters of Cathance River
4 above the Iron Bridge in the village of Bowdoinham in the
5 County of Sagadahoc.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of Section one 2 of this act shall pay a fine of one hundred dollars for each 3 offense.

Sect. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith, 2 so far as the same relates to this act, are repealed.
