STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT for the Better Protection of Smelts in the
Passagassawaukeag River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No smelts shall be taken, or fished for in the
2 Passagassawaukeag river or its tributaries, in any other
3 way than by hook and line above a line two thousand feet
4 below and parallel with the present location of the so-called
5 "Memorial Bridge" at Belfast, under a penalty of one hun-
6 dred dollars for each offense.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.
