STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

AN ACT Relating to Fishing for Smelts in Eastern River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No smelts shall be taken or fished for in the
2 waters of Eastern river, a river lying in the counties of
3 Lincoln and Kennebec, except by hook and line.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provision of this section
2 shall pay a fine of not less than five nor more than one hun-
3 dred dollars and costs for each offense.
