STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Great Pond Railway
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section five of chapter fifty-seven of the pri-
2 vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one
3 incorporating the Great Pond Railway Company, as amend-
4 ed by chapter fifty-three of the private and special laws of
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-three, is hereby further amend-
6 ed as follows:

'A further time of two years from the date when this act
2 goes into effect is hereby extended said railway company
3 for compliance with the privileges of section six of chapter

4 fifty-six of the revised statutes, and a period of three years
5 from the date when this act goes into effect is hereby allowed
6 for beginning actual construction of its road and expend-
7 ing thereon ten per cent of its capital.'

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal
2 or shall be construed as repealing or modifying the whole
3 or any part of said incorporating act or of any existing
4 statute with respect to the rights and privileges or duties
5 and obligations of said railway company to be exercised
6 and performed in accordance with all the applicable pro-
7 visions of chapter fifty-five of the revised statutes and acts
8 amendatory thereof or additional thereto.
