STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, for the Purchase of One Hundred and Fifty
Copies of the History of the Town of Lee.

Resolved: That the state librarian be authorized to purchase one hundred and fifty (150) copies of the History of the Town of Lee by Vinal A. Houghton at a price not exceeding three dollars per copy; and that there be appropriated for this purpose the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

No history of Lee has ever been published. Mr. Houghton has made an exhaustive search of early original records and the result should be preserved in printed form. The material is now in typewritten form only. It has been the policy of the state to aid in the printing of local histories by the purchase of a small number of copies.
