IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, for the Better Preservation, Protection and Perpetuation of Certain Old Forts Situated in this State.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is, appropriated for
2 the better preservation, protection and perpetuation of the
3 two old forts named in this resolve, the sum of thirteen
4 hundred dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth,
5 nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and three hundred dol-
6 lars for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hun-
7 dred and twenty-seven, said sums to be expended from
8 the appropriation made for the care of old forts and under
9 the direction of the governor and council in accordance
10 with the following schedule.

For the better preservation, protection and perpetuation
2 of Fort William Henry in the town of Bristol, the sum of
3 three hundred dollars for the fiscal year ending June thir-
4 tieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and three hundred
5 dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, nineteen
6 hundred and twenty-seven.

For the better preservation, protection and perpetuation
2 of the Fort Halifax block house at Fort Point in the town
3 of Winslow, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal
4 year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-
5 six.
