

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

AN ACT Relating to the Taking of White Perch in Certain
Waters in Washington and Kennebec Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. So much of the existing laws, whether public
2 or private and special, as prohibits taking white perch at
3 any time in Crawford lake and in the tributaries to said
4 lake, in the county of Washington, and the shipment and
5 sale of said white perch within and without the state, is
6 hereby repealed.

Sect. 2. So much of the existing laws, whether public
2 or private and special, as provide for a closed season on

3 white perch in Lake Cobbosseecontee, in the county of Ken-
4 nebec, is hereby repealed.

Sect. 3. This act shall not be construed as repealing that
2 portion of the existing general law establishing a daily limit
3 of fifteen pounds of white perch or not exceeding twenty-
4 five white perch which may be taken in any one day in said
5 waters.
