STATEMENT OF FACTS

The amount awarded in this resolve is to reimburse the various cities and towns for armory rentals for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1924, and for the towns of Caribou, Fort Fairfield, Houlton and Presque Isle for the years 1924 and 1925 on account of stables required to be maintained for mounted organizations.

The appropriation made by the last Legislature for armory rentals was insufficient to pay at the rates heretofore in effect and the amounts set opposite the name of each city and town is that required to make up the balance due under arrangements made with the municipalities in former years.
