## HOUSE AMENDMENT A TO SENATE DOCUMENT NO. 300, NEW DRAFT

#### STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

Amend Senate Document No. 300, new draft, by striking 2 out all of section thirty-four, as far as the word "final" in 3 the twentieth line and inserting in place thereof, the fol-4 lowing:

'Sec. 34. Non-residents may operate motor vehicles and 2 trailers, except those hereinafter enumerated in this section, 3 on the ways of this state for not exceeding twenty days 4 in any one year without registration, provided such ve-5 hicles are registered in some other state or country and 6 have attached thereto registration plates, and are driven by 7 persons licensed to operate in this or some other state or 8 country. Previous to the expiration of said twenty days, 9 if the owner of any such vehicle is to continue its opera-

10 tion within this state, he shall make application to the sec-II retary of state for registration thereof in accordance with 12 section forty-three and pay one-half of the registration fee 13 required of resident owners. On receipt of the fee, the 14 secretary of state shall furnish said non-resident applicant 15 a certificate of registration and appropriate number plates, 16 free of expense, which plates shall be attached to the ve-17 hicle as required by section forty-eight, and remain there 18 as long as such vehicle is operated in this state in the year 19 during which said certificate is issued. Any motor cycle 20 or side car owned by a non-resident, operated by a person 21 registered and authorized to operate it in this or some other 22 state or country, having a registration plate or other dis-23 tinguishing mark attached to the motor cycle, may be oper-24 ated on the ways of this state for not more than twenty 25 days in the aggregate before registration. Provided, how-26 ever, that no motor truck, tractor or trailer used for com-27 mercial purposes and owned by either a resident of this 28 state or a non-resident thereof, shall be operated over any 29 ways or bridges except and until such vehicle is registered 30 and the registration fee paid as provided by statute for the 31 registration of vehicles with like capacity and character 32 owned in this state. Such vehicle when registered as re-33 quired by this section may be operated by persons licensed 34 to operate it according to the laws of this or some other 35 state or country, and may display their register plates in 36 addition to the plates of this state as required by this act.'
