STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Eastern Maine Railroad.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. P. & S. L., 1911, c. 188; charter extended.

- 2 The rights, powers and privileges of the Eastern Maine
- 3 Railroad which were granted by chapter one hundred and
- 4 eighty-eight of the private and special laws of nineteen
- 5 hundred and eleven and have subsequently been amended
- 6 and extended by successive legislatures to date, are hereby
- 7 extended two years additional, and the persons named in
- 8 said act and their associates and successors shall have the
- 9 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them by
- 10 said act and amendments thereof to be exercised by them

II for the same purposes as specified in said act and the 12 amendments thereof.

Sect. 2. Existing statutes not affected; rights conferred 2 subject to R. S., c. 55. Nothing herein contained is in-3 tended to repeal or shall be construed as repealing the whole 4 or any part of any existing statute. And all the rights and 5 duties herein mentioned shall be exercised and performed in 6 accordance with all the applicable provisions of chapter 7 fifty-five of the revised statutes, and acts amendatory there-8 of or additional thereto.
