IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize the State Highway Commission to Co-
operate with the Bureau of Public Roads of the United
States Department of Agriculture in Numbering and Mark-
ing Roads of Interstate Character.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The State highway commission is hereby authorized to co-
2 operate with the Federal government in formulating and
3 adopting a uniform system of numbering, or designating
4 roads of interstate character within this State and in the
5 selection and erection of uniform danger signals and safety
6 devices for the protection and direction of traffic on said
7 highways.
