STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for Penalty for Operating Motor Vehicle
While under Influence of Intoxicating Liquor or Drug.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section seventy-four of chapter two hundred eleven of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-one is hereby
3 amended by striking out the words "one year" in the sixth
4 line and inserting in place thereof the words 'eleven months,'
5 and by striking out the words "months nor more than one
6 year" in the eleventh line, and inserting in place thereof the
7 words 'nor more than eleven months,' so that said section as
8 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 74. No person shall operate or attempt to operate

2 a motor vehicle when intoxicated or at all under the influ-
3 ence of intoxicating liquor or drugs. Whoever violates the
4 foregoing provision shall be punished upon conviction by a
5 fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than one
6 thousand dollars or by imprisonment for not less than thirty
7 days nor more than eleven months, or by both fine and im-
8 prisonment. The license of any person convicted of violat-
9 ing the provisions of this section shall be immediately re-
10 voked by the commission upon receipt of an attested copy
11 of the court records, without further hearing. Any person
12 convicted of a second or subsequent offense shall be pun-
13 ished by imprisonment for not less than three nor more than
14 eleven months and his license to operate shall be revoked by
15 the commission. A copy of sections seventy-two, seventy-
16 three and seventy-four shall be printed on every operator's
17 license.'
