STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide for an Assistant County Attorney for the
County of Androscoggin.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county attorney of the county of Androscoggin may
2 appoint an assistant, to be approved by the justice of the
3 superior court for said county. Said assistant shall take
4 the oath prescribed for county attorneys; and assist the
5 county attorney in the ordinary duties of his office, in the
6 drawing of indictments, in the hearing of complaints before
7 the grand jury, and in the preparation and trial of criminal
8 causes. He shall, when directed by the county attorney, act
9 as counsel for the state in the trial of complaints, before

10 judges of municipal and police courts and trial justices. Said
11 assistant county attorney shall receive an annual salary of
12 twelve hundred dollars.

The county attorney for said county shall receive an annual
2 salary of two thousand dollars. Salaries shall be payable
3 from the state treasury in monthly payments on the last day
4 of each month. The assistant county attorney shall hold
5 his office during the term of the county attorney by whom
6 he was appointed, subject to removal at any time by the
7 justice of the superior court for said county.

All acts or sections thereof, inconsistent with the provisions
2 of this act, are hereby repealed.
