IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

---

AN ACT Authorizing the Caribou Water, Light and Power Company to Lease and Assign to the Great Northern Paper Company for a Period of Thirty Years Its Right to Maintain Piers and Booms and to Hold and Sort Logs and Other Lumber Granted by Chapter 178 of the Private and Special Laws of Maine of 1907.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Caribou Water, Light and Power Company is hereby  
2 authorized to lease, assign, transfer, and set over, for the  
3 period of thirty years, to the Great Northern Paper Com-  
4 pany certain rights, powers and privileges to erect and main-  
5 tain booms and piers and to sort and hold logs and other

6 lumber as granted the former company by an act entitled  
7 “An Act to Amend the Charter of the Caribou Water Light  
8 and Power Company” and being Chapter one hundred and  
9 seventy-eight of the private and special laws of the State of  
10 Maine for the year nineteen hundred and seven.

Said Great Northern Paper Company is hereby authorized  
2 to erect and maintain piers and booms and to hold, store and  
3 sort logs, railroad sleepers, pulpwood and other lumber in  
4 the pond of the first named company in Caribou, for the  
5 full period of thirty years and no longer pursuant to assign-  
6 ment from Caribou Water, Light and Power Company.
