STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Provide a Lien on Potatoes for Storage.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

There shall be a lien on all potatoes stored in warehouses
2 or cellars to secure the payment of storage during period
3 which they are stored, to an amount not exceeding fifteen
4 cents per barrel of one hundred and sixty-five pounds net,
5 which lien shall take precedence of all other claims and in-
6 cumbrances on said potatoes, not made to secure a similar
7 lien, and may be enforced by an attachment at any time be-
8 fore the removal of said potatoes from said warehouse or
9 cellar.
