## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Land Agent to Sell and Convey a Certain Interest of the State in Township One, Range Seven, Penobscot County.

Resolved: That the Land Agent is hereby authorized to 2 sell and convey, consistently with the rights of others there-3 in, to Eugenia A. Powers of Township One, Range Seven, 4 West from the East Line of the State, in Penobscot County, 5 Maine, certain lands in said Township One, Range Seven, 6 constituting part of the school lots of said Township, if he 7 deems advisable, for such price per acre and on such terms 8 of payment as he may deem advantageous; provided, that 9 the proceeds of any sales made shall be added to the school 10 fund of said plantations.
