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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Protect the Fur Bearing Animals of the State  
of Maine.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No person shall hunt, chase, catch, kill, de-  
2 stroy, trap, or have in possession any fur bearing animals  
3 of said state of Maine, or parts thereof, for four years,  
4 from the first day of October, nineteen hundred and twenty-  
5 five, except bobcats, Canada lynx or bear in open season.

This act shall not apply to fur bearing animals raised in  
2 captivity, or belonging to private individuals.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall  
2 be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars, or more  
3 than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment of not more  
4 than sixty days.
