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**STATE OF MAINE**

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Amend Section Ten of Chapter Sixty-four of the  
Revised Statutes, Relating to Marriage.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ten of chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter"  
3 in the second line the words 'or the provisions of section  
4 one of chapter forty-one of the public laws of nineteen hun-  
5 dred nineteen,' so that said section, as amended, shall read  
6 as follows:

'Sect. 10. When residents of this state, with intent to  
2 evade the provisions of sections one, two and three of this  
3 chapter, or the provisions of section one of chapter forty-

4 one of the public laws of nineteen hundred nineteen, and  
5 to return and reside here, go into another state or country,  
6 and there have their marriage solemnized, and afterwards  
7 return and reside here, such marriage is void in this state.
