STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section Five of Chapter One Hundred
and Twenty-two of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Com-
mon Thieves.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section five of chapter one hundred and twenty-two
2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out
3 the word "four" in the fifth line of said section and insert-
4 ing in the place thereof the word 'one,' so that said section
5 as amended will read as follows:

'Sect. 5. Whoever, after being convicted of larceny as
2 principal or as accessory before the fact, is again convicted
3 thereof, or is convicted of three distinct larcenies at the

4 same term of court, shall be deemed a common thief, and
5 be punished by imprisonment for not less than one, nor
6 more than fifteen years.'
