STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Two Hundred Eleven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Twenty-one, Relating to Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Chapter two hundred eleven of the public laws of nine2 teen hundred twenty-one, is hereby amended by adding in
3 section one thereof, after the word "ways" in the second
4 line thereof, the words 'intersecting highway" shall include
5 any public highway which joins another at an angle, whether
6 or not it crosses the other,' so that said section, as amended,
7 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. As used in this chapter, unless the context 2 otherwise indicates, the word "way" includes all kinds of

3 public ways; "intersecting highway" shall include any pub-4 lic highway which joins another at an angle, whether or 5 not it crosses the other; the word "team" and the word 6 "vehicle" shall each include all kinds of conveyances on 7 such ways for persons and for property, except those pro-8 pelled or drawn by human power, or used exclusively on o tracks: the word "trailer" any vehicle for transportation 10 of passengers or commodities without motive power, not 11 operated on tracks, drawn or propelled by a motor vehicle, 12 except a pair of wheels commonly used for other purposes 13 than transportation; the term "solid tires" shall include tires 14 of rubber or other material that do not depend on confined 15 air for the support of the load; the term "motor vehicle," 16 any self-propelled vehicle not operated exclusively on tracks, 17 except tractors; the word "tractor," any self-propelled ve-18 hicle not used on fixed rails, designed or used as a travel-19 ing power plant for drawing vehicles, but having no pro-20 vision for carrying loads independently; the word "owner," 21 any person, firm, corporation or association owning a ve-22 hicle or having exclusive right to the use thereof under 23 contract, lease, hiring, or otherwise; the word "curb," the 24 outer edge of a defined sidewalk, or either edge of the 25 wrought and usually traveled part of a way; the word 26 "section," shall refer to this chapter unless otherwise indi-27 cated; and words in the context of this act indicating oper-28 ation or use of a vehicle refer to its operation or use upon 29 any way or bridge in this state, including public parks and 30 parkways.'
