STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Prevent Illegal Interference with the Business of
Another.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

If any person shall, by force, threats, or intimidation, prevent, or endeavor to prevent, any person employed by another from continuing or performing his work or from accepting any new work or employment; or if any person shall circulate any false written or printed matter, or be concerned in the circulation of any such matter, to induce others not to buy from, or sell to, or have dealings with, any person for the purpose, or with the intent, to prevent such person from employing any person, or to force or

10 compel him to employ or discharge from his employment
11 anyone, or to alter his mode of carrying on his business,
12 or to limit or increase the number of his employees, or the
13 rate of wages or time of service, such person shall be
14 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction there-
15 for, shall be imprisoned in the county jail not more than
16 six nor less than one month, or by fine not less than ten
17 nor more than two hundred dollars.
