IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize Portland University to Confer Certain Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Portland University, a corporation organized under the

general laws of the State of Maine, is hereby authorized

to confer the degrees of bachelor of commercial science

(B. C. S.) after three full years of study; master of commercial science (M. C. S.) after one year of post-graduate

work; and doctor of commercial science (D. C. S.) in cases

where deemed appropriate. Also, to confer the degrees of

bachelor of secretarial science (B. S. S.) after three full

years of study; master of secretarial science (M. S. S.)

10 after one year of post-graduate work; and doctor of sec-11 retarial science (D. S. S.) where deemed appropriate.
