IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section One of Chapter Ten of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Forty-two of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-one, Relating to Poll Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter ten of the revised statutes, as
2 amended by chapter forty-two of the public laws of nineteen
3 hundred and twenty-one, is hereby amended by adding there-
4 to the words 'when the rate of taxation is thirty mills, or
5 less, on a dollar, to which said three dollars there shall be
6 added the sum of twenty cents for each and every mill, above
7 said thirty mills, added to said tax rate,' so that said section,
8 as amended, shall read as follows:

'Sect. 1. *Uniform Poll Tax Established.* A poll tax shall
2 be assessed upon every male inhabitant of the state above
3 the age of twenty-one years whether a citizen of the United
4 States or an alien, in the manner provided by law unless he
5 is exempted therefrom by this chapter, which said poll tax
6 shall be three dollars when the rate of taxation is thirty
7 mills, or less, on a dollar, to which said three dollars there
8 shall be added the sum of twenty cents for each and every
9 mill, above said thirty mills, added to said tax rate.'
