STATE OF MAINE

**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

**AN ACT Relative to Inciting, Inducing, or Persuading
Another to Commit Crime.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whoever wilfully or intentionally, by any means, incites,
2 induces or persuades, or attempts to incite, induce or per-
3 suade, another to commit any crime or offence against the
4 person or property of another, shall, if said crime be a mis-
5 demeanor, be punished by imprisonment not exceeding two
6 years, or by fine not exceeding one thousand dollars.
