STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Prohibiting Ice Fishing in Kennebunk Pond, in the County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time on or through3 the ice in Kennebunk Pond, in the county of York.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-2 sion at any time any kind of fish taken in Kennebunk Pond 3 on or through the ice.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 be subject to a penalty of not less than \$10 nor more than 3 \$30 and costs for each offense, and an additional penalty 4 of \$1 for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession 5 in violation of any provision of this act.

Sect. 3. Trial Justices, Police and Municipal Courts, with-2 in their respective counties shall have, upon complaint, origi-3 nal and concurrent jurisdiction with the Supreme Judicial 4 Court and Superior Courts in all prosecutions arising under 5 this act.
