IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Amending Chapter Fifteen, Section Twenty-five, Revised Statutes, Relative to the State Highway Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section fifteen of chapter twenty-five of the revised stat-2 utes is hereby amended by striking out the whole of said

- 3 section and substituting in place thereof the following:
- 'Sect. 15. The provisions of section fourteen of chapter
- 2 sixty and of sections one hundred and sixteen to one hun-
- 3 dred and twenty-five, both inclusive, of chapter twenty-four,
- 4 relating to the repair of streets dug into, may be enforced
- 5 by the commission wherever state or state aid highways are
- 6 affected. The commission is authorized in its discretion

7 where state and state aid highways are blocked or encum8 bered with snow, to cause so much of the snow to be re9 moved as will render said highways passable and facilitate
10 public travel, but no town in which a state or state aid high11 way lies shall be relieved from any obligations of statute
12 relating to ways blocked or encumbered with snow, anything

13 to the contrary elsewhere in this chapter notwithstanding.'
