RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Sell and Convey a Certain Interest of the State in Township One, Range Seven, Penobscot County.

Resolved: That the forest commissioner is hereby authorized to sell and convey, consistently with the rights of others therein, to Eugenia A. Powers, an actual settler on Township One, Range Seven, west from the east line of the state, in Penobscot county, Maine, certain lands in said Township One, Range Seven, constituting part of the school lots of said township, if he deems advisable, for such price per acre and on such terms of payment as he may deem advantageous; provided, that the proceeds of any sales made shall be added to the school fund of said plantation.
