HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Permit Ice Fishing in Bauneg Beg Pond, So
Called, in Sanford and in North Berwick, in the County of
York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

So much of the existing rules and regulations of the de-
2 partment of inland fisheries and game, promulgated in ac-
3 cordance with law, as prohibits fishing through the ice in
4 Bauneg Beg pond, so-called, which pond is situated partly
5 in the town of Sanford and partly in the town of North
6 Berwick, in the county of York, in accordance with the
7 general ice fishing law of the state applying to York county,
8 is hereby repealed.
