AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty-six of Chapter One Hundred Forty-four of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three Entitled "An Act to Revise and Consolidate the Banking Laws of This State."

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-six of chapter one hundred forty-four of 2 the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-three is 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "advertise- 4 ment" in the eighth line the words 'once a week' and by 5 striking out the word "sixty" in the twelfth line and insert- 6 ing in the place thereof the word 'thirty' and by striking 7 out the word "last" at the end of the twelfth line and insert-

8 ing in the place thereof the word 'first,' so that said section  
9 as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 26. Duplicate book of deposit, in case of loss of  
2 original. When the person to whom a book of deposit was  
3 issued by any savings bank or by any trust company for a  
4 deposit in its savings department, or his executor, or ad-  
5 ministrator, or guardian, in writing notifies the treasurer  
6 of the bank or trust company issuing the same, that such  
7 book is lost, and that he desires to have a duplicate book  
8 of deposit issued to him, said treasurer shall give public  
9 notice of such application by publishing at the expense of  
10 such applicant, an advertisement once a week for three  
11 weeks successively, in some newspaper published in the  
12 town in which said bank or trust company is located, if any,  
13 otherwise in one published in the county, if any, and if not,  
14 then in the state paper. If such missing deposit book is not  
15 presented to said treasurer within thirty days after the first  
16 advertisement, then he shall issue a duplicate book of deposit  
17 to the person thus requesting the same, and such delivery  
18 of a duplicate relieves said bank from all liability on account  
19 of the original book of deposit so advertised.
