STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Providing for the Purchase of the Book to Be
Issued by the Maine State Bar Association in Commemora-
tion of the Adoption of the Constitutions of the United States
and of Maine.

Resolved: That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) is
2 hereby appropriated for the purchase from the Maine State
3 Bar Association of copies of the book to be issued by it in
4 commemoration of the adoption of the constitutions of the
5 United States and of Maine and of their preservation, at
6 the same cost per copy as the cost to the association; said
7 books to be distributed or exchanged at the discretion of the
8 state librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Maine State Bar Association at its meeting January 14, 1925, commemorated the adoption of the Constitutions of the United States and of Maine and of their preservation. All these proceedings will be printed in durable book form. The historical matter which will be contained in them will be of much value to the citizens of the state and promotive of their knowledge of the constitutions and their fundamental principles.

The appropriation is to purchase, while the report is being printed, additional copies at cost for distribution and exchange by the state librarian with the libraries throughout Maine and other states and for distribution to the citizens of Maine.
