STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Allowance for Clerks in the Register of
Deeds of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-five of chapter one hundred and seventeen
2 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter two hun-
3 dred and nineteen of the public laws of nineteen hundred
4 and twenty-one, is hereby amended by striking out the words
5 "thirty-eight hundred and fifty-two" in the second and
6 third lines of paragraph four of said section forty-five, and
7 inserting instead thereof the words 'forty-eight hundred and
8 fifty-two,' so that said fourth paragraph of said section
9 forty-five as amended shall read as follows:

'Cumberland county: For clerks in the office of register
2 of deeds, forty-eight hundred and fifty-two dollars; deputy
3 register of deeds, eleven hundred and forty-four dollars;
4 for clerks in the office of register of probate, thirty-two
5 hundred and seventy-two dollars; for clerks in the office of
6 clerk of courts, forty-three hundred and twenty-four dol-
7 lars; for clerks in the office of recorder of the Portland
8 municipal court, sixteen hundred and twelve dollars; for
9 clerks in the office of county attorney, seven hundred and
10 forty-two dollars; for clerks in the office of sheriff, seven
11 hundred and twenty-eight dollars; for clerks in the office
12 of county treasurer, seven hundred and twenty-eight dollars.'
