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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

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AN ACT to Amend Chapter Thirty-nine of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen to Fix the Salary of the Judge and Recorder of the Sanford Municipal Court.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter thirty-nine of the public laws of 2 nineteen hundred and fifteen is hereby amended by striking 3 out after the word "of" in the second line thereof and be- 4 fore the word "payable" in the third line thereof the words 5 "one thousand dollars" and inserting therein the words 6 'fourteen hundred dollars,' so that the section as amended 7 shall read as follows:

'Section 1. The judge of the Sanford municipal court 2 shall receive as compensation an annual salary of fourteen

3 hundred dollars, payable quarterly, on the first days of Jan-  
4 uary, April, July and October, from the county treasury  
5 of the county of York. He shall account, quarterly, under  
6 oath to the treasurer of said county for all fees received by  
7 him, or payable to him by virtue of his office, specifying  
8 the items, and shall pay the whole amount of the same to  
9 the treasurer of the county of York.'
