STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Change the Salary of the State Superintendent of the State School for Boys.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section twenty-nine of chapter one hundred and seventeen of the revised statutes as amended by section six of chapter one hundred and thirty of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seventeen is hereby amended by striking out the words "fifteen hundred dollars" and inserting in place thereof, 'two thousand dollars,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 29. INCREASED TO TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS A YEAR. The superintendent of the state school
