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AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-eight of Chapter Twenty-four of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Powers and Liabilities of Plantations.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-eight of chapter twenty-four of the revised  
2 statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said sec-  
3 tion and substituting in place thereof the following:

‘Sect. 48. Organized plantations have like powers and are  
2 subject to like liabilities and penalties as towns respecting  
3 ways. Their assessors have like powers and shall perform  
4 like duties, as municipal officers of towns, respecting them.’
