STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Providing for a Rebate to Organized Plantations,
Towns or Cities of State Taxes on Certain Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Whenever the state of Maine owns or holds land located
2 in any organized plantation, town or city, the state assessors
3 shall annually place a valuation on such land, exclusive of
4 buildings, and shall rebate to such plantation, town or city
5 annually an amount of money equal to the sum produced
6 by multiplying such valuation by the state tax rate for the
7 current year, such rebate to be allowed as a credit to such
8 plantation, town or city on the state tax assessed against it.
