STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Authority of the State Highway Commission Within the Limits of State Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The state highway commission shall have con-

- 2 trol and supervision within the limits and boundaries of all
- 3 state highways defined in section five of chapter twenty-five
- 4 of the revised statutes of all buildings, structures, stands,
- 5 or obstructions therein erected or maintained.

Sect. 2. Without first obtaining a written permit from

- 2 said state highway commission therefor, no building, struc-
- 3 ture, stand or obstruction shall be erected or maintained
- 4 within the limits and boundaries of the right of way of such

- 5 state highway, and such right of way shall be deemed the 6 full width of the road as laid out by the county or by the 7 town.
- Sect. 3. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this 2 act, shall be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars 3 nor more than one hundred dollars for each offense.
