STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Certain State Parks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. All that portion of the state lands comprising
2 Fort Machias at Machias; Fort Knox at Prospect; Fort
3 Edgecomb at Edgecomb; Fort St. George's at St. George;
4 Fort McClary at Kittery; Fort Baldwin, Fort Popham and
5 the North and South Sugar Loaf Islands at Phippsburg,
6 are hereby created public parks.

Sect. 2. The supervision, direction and control of the
2 same are hereby vested in the governor and council.

Sect. 3. To effectuate the purposes of this act, there is

2 hereby appropriated the sum of three thousand (\$3,000)
3 dollars for the year nineteen hundred twenty-six and the
4 sum of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars for the year nine-
5 teen hundred twenty-seven.

Sect. 4. The governor and council are hereby authorized
2 to receive moneys by gift or legacy and shall hold same as
3 trustees for the purposes stated in section one of this act.

Sect. 5. The expenditure of all moneys provided for in
2 this act shall be under the direction of the governor and
3 council and an annual report of the same shall be made to
4 the state auditor who shall audit the same.
