STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Restricting Hunting on Dry Pond, in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section I. For a period of four years from September
2 first, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, it shall be unlawful
3 for any person to hunt, pursue, shoot at or kill any wild bird
4 or wild animal at any time on Dry Pond or from the shores
5 of said pond, which pond is situated in the town of Gray,
6 in the county of Cumberland.

Sect. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have 2 in possession at any time any wild bird or wild animal taken 3 in violation of any provision of these regulations.

Sect. 3. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall

2 be subject to a penalty of not less than five nor more than3 fifty dollars and costs for each offense, or imprisonment4 for thirty days, or both said fine and imprisonment.
