**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE**

AN ACT to Authorize the County Commissioners of the County of Hancock to Locate, Lay Out and Establish a County Way in Tide Waters of Eggemoggin Reach in Said County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The county commissioners of the county of Hancock are
2 hereby authorized to locate, lay out, and establish a county
3 way, together with necessary land for approach and erections
4 against physical changes, the sea, and elements generally,
5 between high and low water mark, at point of lowest ebb,
6 on Eggemoggin Reach, in the town of Sedgwick, in said
7 county of Hancock, being bound on the west by line run-
8 ning parallel with and not more than three feet from the

9 western side line of the wooden ferry approach now in use
10 in the premises, and on the east by a line parallel with and
11 not more than sixty feet from the eastern side line of said
12 approach, said lines extending from high to low water at
13 lowest ebb thereof.
