STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Judge of the Kennebunk Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter fifteen of the private and special laws for the year
2 nineteen hundred and twenty-three is hereby amended by
3 striking out in the second line of section fifteen thereof, the
4 word "six" and inserting in place thereof the word 'eight,'
5 so that said section so far as it relates to the salary of the
6 judge of the municipal court of Kennebunk shall read as
7 follows:

'The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of
2 eight hundred dollars per annum, to be paid him by the
3 county of York.'
