STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Amend Section Three of the Public Laws of Nine-
teen Hundred and Twenty-three, Relating to Retiring and
Pensioning State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section three of chapter one hundred and ninety-nine
2 of the public laws of nineteen hundred and twenty-
3 three is hereby amended by inserting after the word
4 "schools" in the third line of said section the words 'and
5 the Madawaska Training School,' so that said section as
6 amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. "Employee" defined: The word employee shall
2 be held to include clerks and other employees of the sev-

3 eral state departments and state institutions; also teachers
4 in the state normal schools and the Madawaska Training
5 school, including such teachers as have retired since March
6 first, nineteen hundred and twenty.'
