RESOLVE, in Favor of F. W. Cunningham & Sons for Contractors' Fees as per Contract with the State Dated October, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-three, in Connection with the State Prison, Thomaston, Maine, Together with Disbursements.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of four thousand six hundred and eighty-four dollars
3 and forty-seven cents (\$4,684.47) to be paid to F. W. Cun-
4 ningham & Sons of Portland, Maine, in full payment, satis-
5 faction and discharge of all claims and demands arising or
6 growing out of a certain contract by and between the state
7 of Maine and said F. W. Cunningham & Sons dated Octo-

8 ber.nineteen hundred and twenty-three, relating to
9 the repairs and rebuilding of certain buildings at the state
10 prison at Thomaston, Maine, together with all cash disburse-
11 ments in connection therewith.
