STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Purpose of Operating Fish Hatcheries and Feeding Stations for Fish, for the Protection of Fish, Game and Birds and for Printing the Report of the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game, and for Maintenance of the Maine State Museum and for Other Expenses Incident to the Administration of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game.

Resolved: That the sum of three hundred and seventy 2 thousand dollars be, and hereby is, appropriated, as follows:

One hundred and eighty-five thousand dollars for the period 2 between July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, and 3 June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and one

4 hundred and eighty-five thousand dollars for the period be-
5 tween July first, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, and June
6 thirtieth, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven, to be expended
7 by the commissioner of inland fisheries and game for the
8 purpose of operating the fish hatcheries and feeding sta-
9 tions for fish in the state, for the protection of fish, game
10 and birds, for printing the report of the commissioner of
11 inland fisheries and game, for maintenance of the Maine
12 State Museum, payment of bounty on bob-cats killed in this
13 state, and all other expenses incident to the administration
14 of the department of inland fisheries and game, and that
15 any of this appropriation unexpended at the end of either
16 year shall be available for the following year.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is the usual resolve for maintenance of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, which includes operation of twelve fish hatcheries for the propagation of fish. This is the same amount which was appropriated by the legislature of nineteen hundred and twenty-three for the two past fiscal years, and the same amount recommended by the budget committee to the present legislature.
