SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to Senate Paper No. 45,
Senate Document No. 156.

The second paragraph of said bill is hereby amended by
2 striking out the words "one dollar" in the third line of said
3 second paragraph and inserting instead thereof the words
4 'seventy-five cents,' so that said second paragraph as amend-
5 ed shall read as follows:

'Sect. 18. Registers of deeds shall receive for recording
2 a deed, mortgage or lease or description of a family bury-
3 ing ground, seventy-five cents.'
