STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Making Uniform the Registration of Married Women
as Voters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Every married woman now registered, or who
2 shall hereafter register, as a voter, shall be registered under
3 her given and married surname.

Sect. 2. Whenever an unmarried registered woman voter
2 shall assume through marriage, or a married registered
3 woman voter shall assume through any process of law a
4 new surname, she shall notify the registration board of said
5 change, in person, and the board shall then re-register in
6 accordance with the preceding section.
