STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Librarian to Purchase Copies of "The History of Winthrop."

Resolved: That the State Librarian be, and hereby is, 2 authorized, empowered and directed to purchase one hundred 3 fifty copies of the book entitled "History of Winthrop," by 4 E. S. Stackpole, at seven dollars per copy and the sum of 5 ten hundred fifty dollars is hereby appropriated therefor.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of Winthrop was incorporated in April, 1771. Hence is nearly one hundred fifty-four years old. Considerable historical and genealogical data was secured by the late Hon. John M. Benjamin. Since his death this was purchased by the town from his estate; the services of E. S. Stackpole, LL.D. were secured by the town and he has given a great deal of time and endeavor to make this a complete history. The committee has estimated that this work will cost seven dollars per volume.
