STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Authorize the Payment of Retirement Compensation to Treasurers and Assistant Treasurers of Savings Banks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
The trustees, with the approval of the incorporators of
2 any Mutual Savings Bank, organized under the laws of
3 this State may, when in their judgment the interests of
4 the institution make it advisable, subject to the written
5 approval of the Bank Commissioner, retire any Treasurer
6 or Assistant Treasurer of such Savings Bank, who has been
7 in the employ of such institution in any capacity for not
8 less than fifteen years and pay such official a retirement com-

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9 pensation of such amount and at such periods as in their 10 judgment the circumstances require. Written notice of 11 such proposed action shall be given to each trustee and 12 incorporator at least seven days prior to any action thereon.
