Fire Pump and Hydrants\$5,000.00

Addition to Cottage C\$5,000.00

STATEMENT OF FACTS

By reason of the low pressure of water at the present time, the lives of the patients would be endangered in case of fire.

An addition to Cottage C is necessary to provide room for patients who are very sick, or who are in a dying condition.
