STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND TWENTY-FIVE

Amend by striking out all of said bill and inserting in place
2 thereof the following :

The stenographers appointed by any justice of the supreme
2 judicial court or either justice of the superior courts shall
3 in addition to the duties now prescribed by statute perform,
4 or furnish, such other official and clerical services as may
5 be required by the appointing justice.
